



**Biography of

Mr. U. K. Sinha was appointed as Chairman of Securities & Exchange Board of India with effect from February 18, 2011

Chairman Mr. Sinha, formerly from the Indian Administrative Service - the civil service in India, brings with him rich experience in the financial markets for more than a decade. Prior to taking over as Chairman at SEBI, he was Chairman & Managing Director of UTI Asset Management Company Ltd. and Chairman of Association of Mutual Funds in India. He has earlier held several key positions with distinction in the Ministry of Finance, Government of India and has actively contributed to the financial sector reforms in the country. He is also credited with starting the micro pension movement in India.

He was also the Chairman of the Working Group on Foreign Investment in India formed by the Government of India. He was a member of several committees set up by the Government of India including the Committees on Liquidity Management, Foreign Institutional Investors, Corporate Bond Market and Investor Protection.

Mr. Sinha is also currently Chairman of the Asia Pacific Regional Committee of International Organization of Securities Commissions (IOSCO).
